

# ROBIN COSGROVE PRIZE FOR ETHICS IN FINANCE 2009

## The Nominees

The second edition of the **Robin Cosgrove Prize for Ethics in Finance** was launched in June 2008. The Prizes attracted an excellent response in 2009, with some very high quality papers.

After very thorough reviews and discussions, the Jury has short-listed a group of 8 papers that are the **Nominees for the Robin Cosgrove Prize for Ethics in Finance**:

- Pernille JESSEN, *Implementing Ethics in Finance: Investment as if People & Planet mattered* - Danish, Student
- Meredith BENTON, *Innovative Ideas for Ethics in Finance* - American, Student
- David SIFAH, *Financial Ethics* - Ghanaian, Banker
- Marie CASIMIRO and Elise PELLERIN, *Du bon usage de l'Ordre dans le désordre de la finance* - French, Portfolio Management
- Leire SAN JOSE, *Ethics in cash management. Mutual cash holding as an answer* - Spain, University Professor
- Felipe ARAÚJO, *Ethics, the key to credibility* - Brazilian, Student

The Jury is now deliberating the choice of one or more prizewinners and, if more than one is selected, how to allocate the sum of **USD 20,000** between them.

The Robin Cosgrove Prize will be awarded in a ceremony on **22 October 2009 in Geneva**, which will be part of the annual conference of the Observatoire de la Finance.

In addition, the nominees' texts will be published in a special issue of our review *Finance & the Common Good/Bien Commun*, which will be distributed during the awarding ceremony.
